1 Basis of Preparation and Accounting policies

The interim financial report has been prepared under the historical cost basis except for the following assets and liabilities which are measured at fair values: properties included within property, plant and equipment as disclosed in note 10, investment properties, and derivatives.

The Interim Financial Report is unaudited and has been prepared in compliance with FRS No.134, "Interim Financial Reporting" and Paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad. It should be read in conjunction with the Group's most recent audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2010.

The significant accounting policies adopted are consistent with those adopted in the audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2010, except for the adoption of the following Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") and Issues Committee ("IC") Interpretations:

Except for the changes in accounting policies arising from the adoption of the revised FRS 3 and, the amendments to FRS 127, as well as the new disclosures required under the Amendments to FRS 7, the Board of Directors expect that the adoption of the other standards and interpretations above will have no material impact on the financial statements in the period of initial application. The nature of the changes in accounting policy on adoption of the revised FRS 3 and the amendments to FRS 127 which are effective for annual periods beginning on or after 1 July 2010 are described below.

The revised FRS 3 introduces a number of changes in the accounting for business combinations occurring after 1 July 2010. These changes will impact the amount of goodwill recognised, the reported results in the period that an acquisition occurs, and future reported results. The Amendments to FRS 127 require that a change in the ownership interest of a subsidiary (without loss of control) is accounted for as an equity transaction. Therefore, such transactions will no longer give rise to goodwill, nor will they give rise to a gain or loss. Furthermore, the amended standard changes the accounting for losses incurred by the subsidiary as well as the loss of control of a subsidiary. Other consequential amendments have been made to FRS 107 Statement of Cash Flows, FRS 112 Income Taxes, FRS 121 The Effects of Changes in Foreign Exchange Rates, FRS 128 Investments in Associates and FRS 131 Interests in Joint Ventures.

The changes from revised FRS 3 and Amendments to FRS 127 has affected the Group's acquisition of an additional 4% equity interest in First SGC Pte Ltd ("FSGC") from the minority interests for a cash consideration of S\$ 1.45 million equivalent to RM 3.5 million. This acquisition has been accounted for as an equity transaction as reflected in the Consolidated Statement of Changes in Equity.

10 Valuations of Property, Plant and Equipment

The carrying value of land and buildings is based on a valuation carried out in the year ended 31 December 2009 by independent qualified valuers using the comparison and depreciated replacement cost methods to reflect their market value.

11 Significant Post Balance Sheet Events

On 4th November 2011, the Group's 70% owned subsidiary company, First SGC Pte Ltd, entered into a Sale and Purchase Agreement with Santai Science & Technology Co Ltd to dispose of its 49% equity stake in Xiamen Maidiken Science & Technology Co Ltd ('MDK') for a consideration of RMB 70 million. Completion is expected within 90 days of the approval from Department of Foreign Investment Administration of the Ministry of Commerce of the People's Republic of China.

Other than the above, there were no significant events that had arisen subsequent to the end of this current period.

12 Changes in Group Composition

The Group did not undertake any business combinations, acquisitions or disposals of subsidiaries and long-term investments, restructuring or discontinuation of operations during the current period ended 30 September 2011.

13 Reclassification

In the current quarter, the Board of Directors approved the plan to dispose the Group's investment in Associate, Xiamen Maidiken Science & Technology Co. Ltd, China and instructed Management to locate a buyer to sell the asset at a price that is fair and reasonable to Group. In accordance with FRS 5: Non-current Assets Held for Sale and Discontinued Operations, the investment has been reclassified to an Asset or Disposal Group classified as held for sale and re-measured at the lower of its carrying amount and fair value less costs to sell.

14 Changes in Contingent liabilities or Contingent assets.

There were no contingent liabilities or contingent assets of the Group since the end of the last annual balance sheet date.

16 Related Party Transactions

There were no related party transactions during the period ended 30 September 2011.

17 Review of Performance

The Group's revenue for the third quarter of 2011 grew year on year by 13% to RM 91.8 million from RM 81.6 million for the same period last year. However, profit before tax of RM 6.1 million for the current quarter is 33% lower than the RM 9.1 million achieved for the same period in 2010. Year to date, the Group achieved profit before tax of RM 26.5 million on revenue on RM 273.7 million, representing increases of 3% and 16% respectively over that in 2010.

Core business operations performed well, with good growth in revenue and profit over 2010. The Group's manufacturing unit, Xepa^{SP} performed well, supported by strong sales in the domestic and Singapore markets, with year to date revenue and profit before tax grew by 9% and 19% over 2010.

Revenue and profit at Apex Pharma wholesale, distribution and marketing unit likewise showed good growth of 27% and 24% respectively over 2010. The Group's own products under the AVEX, AVO, AGNESIA and KAP brands increased market share with a growing number of customers. AGNESIA and KAPS products were exported or the first time to Uganda. Revenue from Singapore operations under Apex Pharma Marketing Pte Ltd grew steadily, supported by newly acquired agencies.

In the current quarter, the Group decided to seek an exit for its investment in Associate, Xiamen Maidiken Science & Technology Co Ltd ('MDK') in China held by its 70% owned subsidiary, First SGC Pte Ltd ("FSGC") as MDK no longer fits the Group's long term strategic business goals. Key reasons include the inability of MDK to secure market access for the Group's product into the Chinese market and the Company's reduced effective equity interest of 16% in the key operating unit, Luyan (Fujian) Pharma Co Ltd. In accordance with the requirements of FRS 5: Non-current Assets Held For Sale and Discontinued Operations, the Group re-measured its investment to the lower of carrying amount and fair value less cost to sell resulting in an impairment of RM 2.2 million arising from estimated capital gain tax and transaction costs.

As previously announced on 4th November 2011, the Group's net proceeds of RM 33.1 million plus the dividend received to date of RM1.5 million from its investment in MDK represents a gain of RM 15.3 million above what the Group has invested in cash, or a return of 79.3% over the course of 6 years.

18 Material changes in the profit before tax for the quarter

Profit before tax for the current quarter is RM 6.1 million, which is 30% lower than the RM 8.8 million achieved in the immediate preceding quarter. This is attributed to the Group's decision to seek an exit for its investment in MDK, as elaborated in Note 17 above.

19 Commentary

(a) Prospects

Core operations performed well in the third quarter, driven by the Group's commitment and focus on product development, brand management, customer service and operational efficiency. The overall economic outlook remains uncertain, but barring further unforeseen circumstances, the Board is cautiously optimistic that performance for 2011 will be satisfactory.
